Calmette & Yersin Internship Grants

2024 Call for Applications

To provide unique opportunities to talented young scientists, Institut Pasteur through the Calmette and Yersin program launched the call for internship grants.

The grant amount is €1200 monthly pro-rata for a period of up- to 3 months or 6 months (specifically for Master students and is meant to support part of the onsite expenses of the intern (accommodation, food and transport). The travel expenses to reach the internship location are not included and must be provided by the intern's Sending Institute.

This call will be **open all year long** and **selections** will take place **4 times a year** with the Selection Committee gathering on the dates below. Applications submitted after a Selection Committee has taken place will automatically be evaluated in the next batch of applications:

- 11th of March
- 10th of June
- 19th of September
- 17th of December

To ensure proper planning and coordination, it is essential to allow for a **period of 3 months between the award of the grant and the start of the internship**, so that the candidate can complete the administrative procedure related to the mobility.

It is encouraged to start the VISA application as soon as the candidate receives the confirmation letter of acceptance to the program.

In collaboration with their future host supervisor, Applicants must propose an innovative research project within the scope of the scientific priorities of the Pasteur Network.

Applications must be written in English and submitted online.

Incomplete or paper-based applications will not be considered.

Carefully review the grant guidelines before applying. Please be attentive to eligibility criteria, application deadlines, and any specific requirements or restrictions.
