



## **Calmette & Yersin Postdoctoral Grant**

## Call for Applications 2025

The Pasteur Network (PN), which brings together more than 30 institutes, plays a central role in responding to global public health issues. Its uniqueness lies in its scientific and cultural diversity, its geographical coverage, with 25 countries on 5 continents, and its shared values. This enables us to draw on a broad scientific community, and promotes the sharing of knowledge and expertise. Recognized as a WHO non-state actor, the Pasteur Network is often associated with local ministries of health. It promotes a global public health research capacity comprising over 50 national and regional reference laboratories and 17 WHO Collaborating Centers.

In order to offer unique opportunities to talented young scientists, Institut Pasteur, through the Calmette & Yersin program, is launching a call for applications 2025 for two (2) postdoctoral fellowships.

The Calmette & Yersin program will fund 2 new postdoctoral fellowships. Applicants must propose an innovative research project in line with the scientific priorities of the host institute and the SPARK 2025 call.

In order to support collaborations proposed in SPARK projects, PN Institutes located in low- or middle-income countries will benefit from priority access to a Calmette & Yersin (C&Y) postdoctoral fellowship for a maximum duration of 24 months (irrespective of the duration of the project), provided that the postdoctorates are carried out in these Institutes.

Applications must be written in English or French and submitted <u>online</u> by September 8, 2025, 1:00 pm (Paris time) at the latest. Incomplete or paper applications will not be considered.

Applications must be submitted via the <u>Application Portal</u>. Before applying, please read the recommendations carefully. Please also note the eligibility criteria, application deadlines and any specific requirements or restrictions.
