

FIOCRUZ - PASTEUR - USP Call for Project Proposals 2018

Fundação Oswaldo Cruz - Institut Pasteur International Network - Universidade de São Paulo

SUMMARY

The call for proposals for projects involving the Institut Pasteur International Network, Fundação Oswaldo Cruz (Fiocruz) and the Universidade de São Paulo (USP) is now open.

The main objective is to facilitate the collaborations in priority areas of research and public health programs, particularly in the framework of the tripartite agreement signed between Institut Pasteur, Fiocruz, USP on June 8th, 2015 and of the Memorandum of Understanding signed on 28 July 2017 between Institut Pasteur, Fiocruz, USP and FUSP.

The proposals should bring together researchers or teams from at least one institute member of the Institut Pasteur International Network (<http://databaseriip.pasteur.fr>), of the Fundação Oswaldo Cruz and of the Universidade de São Paulo.

The deadline for submitting applications is November 19th, 2018.

1. PASTEUR - FIOCRUZ - USP PROGRAM

The Pasteur - Fiocruz - USP Program aims at consolidating the scientific cooperation between researchers of the three institutions, in the framework of the tripartite agreement signed between Institut Pasteur, Fiocruz and USP, on June 8th, 2015.

2. RESEARCH COLLABORATION GRANTS

2.1. Goals of this grant

- To promote and facilitate high quality and long-term collaboration between faculty/researchers at the partner institutions in areas of strategic importance;
- To promote academic mobility;
- To facilitate the publication of high quality joint research papers;
- To facilitate the submission of high quality research bids.

2.2. Eligibility

- The proposals shall be embedded in the following priorities:
 - Vector-borne infectious (emerging and re-emerging) diseases
 - Effects of climate changes in vector migration
 - Neurosciences
 - Translational medicine and development two transversal methodological approaches: system biology and population biology

- One “Pasteur”, one “Fiocruz” and one “USP” coordinator will be identified when submitting the application form. The coordinators will be responsible for the supervision and execution of the project both scientifically and administratively.

2.3. Ineligibility

- The researchers who have ongoing projects from past calls cannot submit any other project to this call.
- The members of the Coordination Committee of the Fiocruz-USP-Pasteur Scientific Cooperation Agreement are also ineligible to submit projects to this call.

2.4. Funding and duration

- Funding up to 90 k€ will be made available for the selected projects, being 30 k€ per institution, to be executed between December 2018 and November 2020.
- Details on the financial conditions of use will be given to the granted projects coordinators, in line with the financial policies of each institution.
- Proposal with funding from other institutions or organizations are encouraged. Please, indicate this in your proposal.

2.5. Eligible costs

- Travel costs
- Accommodation
- Subsistence
- Project consumables

2.6. Format and Guidelines

Identical project proposals should be applied in English by Pasteur, Fiocruz and USP coordinators.
